RELEASE OF LIABILITY, PHOTO RELEASE AND CONSENT TO MEDICAL TREATMENT

- Release of liability.** I, for myself, my minor child and for the child's other parent and/or guardian, hereby release, waive, discharge, and covenant not to sue First Baptist Church of Delhi, and its officers, director, employees, agents, volunteers, heirs and assigns of and from all liability, loss, claims, demands, possible causes of action, court costs, attorneys' fees and other expenses arising from any lawsuit that may otherwise occur from any loss, damage or injury to my child's person or property in any way resulting from or connected with my child's attendance at Awana, including, without limitation, the failure of anyone to enforce rules and regulations, failure to make inspections, or the negligence of other persons.
- Photo Release:** I give permission for my child's photo, which may be taken during Awana to appear on the church website www.delhifbc.com or be used for publicity or display purposes via social media or print.
- Consent to Medical Treatment.** In the event my child becomes ill or injured, I give permission for a representative of First Baptist Church of Delhi to take whatever steps are reasonably necessary to render emergency first aid to my child. I also consent to such emergency medical treatment as may be reasonably necessary to render emergency first aid to my child. I also consent to such emergency medical treatment as may be reasonably necessary to insure the health and welfare of my child including, but not limited to, x-rays, anesthetic, medical or surgical diagnosis and treatment, hospital care and administration of drugs or medicine under the care of a licensed physician and/or surgeon.

FBC AWANA DISCIPLINE POLICY

We believe that Awana participation is a privilege. We also believe that discipline is at the very core of the Awana program. Fair and impartial discipline is for all clubbers as Jesus' example shows in Romans 2:11 and Acts 10:34.

The purpose of discipline is to teach acceptable behavior, not merely a set of rules. To discipline is to teach - resulting in a happy, well-adjusted individual. Discipline is NOT punishment.

We institute discipline through the following:

"Five Count" – this is used for getting the attention of a group of clubbers. The person in charge calls out clearly and loudly numbers 1 – 5. At the end of the count the clubbers should be quiet with attention on the person in charge.

"Three Count" – this is used for disciplining an individual clubber who *continues* to misbehave after repeated correction/counseling...following the "3-strikes-you're-out" philosophy.

Things that would be considered *strikes*:

1. Disrespect of leaders – rude, talking back, arguing, poor attitude and willful disobedience
2. Disrespect (intentional damage) to church property
3. Fighting
4. Unnecessary roughness – including Game Time
5. Cursing, name calling, foul language
6. Failure to pass sections (1 section every 2 club nights is required)
7. Stealing

Each time a clubber is given a strike, the clubber **WILL** be taken aside **IMMEDIATELY** and counseled by the leader in a loving manner. Explaining

1. what the clubber did wrong
2. the acceptable rules and the consequences of not following them
3. and encouraged to continue in club but with corrective action on the clubbers part

This counseling will be documented in a Discipline Notebook (kept by the Director). Documentation **MUST** be made the same night as the offense but not necessarily at the time of the incident. See- *Discipline Action Form*

If the clubber repeatedly misbehaves after having been counseled for 3 separate incidents – the clubber will be removed from club (sent home) for 2 weeks. Clubber may be taken home by Awana leaders OR if parents are not available, they may be met after club night

to explain what has happened, why the clubber is being expelled and for how long. Following the two week expulsion the clubber is welcome to return to club, however if the clubber misbehaves a 4th time the clubber will be expelled for the remainder of the club year.

Only clubbers in good standing (those who follow the rules) and participate will be eligible for awards/incentives.

The Awana Discipline Committee has prayed together and set forth these standards to protect and preserve an orderly experience for all children. We reserve the right to exclude uncooperative clubbers.
